Blue Box Recycling Program Update

The Township of Brudenell, Lyndoch and Raglan would like to share an important update regarding Ontario's Blue Box recycling program and changes that affect how recycling services are delivered in the community. Transition to Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR). This province-wide change is designed to create a more efficient and sustainable recycling system that supports a circular economy. Under EPR, the responsibility for recycling packaging and paper products shifts from municipalities to producers — the companies that create and supply these materials to consumers. This includes many of the familiar brands and retailers Ontarians interact with every day.

What This Means for Residents:

The Blue Box Recycling Program will continue, with improvements over time. Recycling services will be 100% funded by producers, not by the municipalities. The program aims to recycle more materials, more easily, with greater consistency across Ontario.
